STEP 1: PARTICIPANT CENTER REGISTRATION

- 1) Go to www.chwevents.org/wfca
- 2) Click "Register" in upper right-hand corner
- 3) Click "Join a team"
- 4) In the Team Name box type in your exact team name

- 5) Click "Join"
- 6) Choose "Player" as your participation type
- 7) Enter your fundraising goal, then hit Next Step
- 8) Join as a new participant
- 9) Enter the required registration information, then hit Next Step

- 11) Select complete your registration

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

- Reach out to your schools Booster/Gridiron Club.

 - Many companies have matching gift programs and will match any charitable contributions made by their employees. Be sure to ask your donors if their workplaces offers this incentive.
- Hold a treat sale (baked goods, candy or fruit & nuts).
 - These types of initiatives never go out of style. Who doesn't love buying treats that benefit a worthy cause?
- Host a car wash.
 - Find a gas station willing to provide you with their space and hose hook up.
 Car washes can be for a fee or a suggested donation. Rally your teammates together to join you in your fundraising efforts.
- Grow beards, take a polar plunge, or race rubber ducks in a pond!
 - Creativity and fun goes a long way in fundraising. Share on social media to build awareness for your event.
- Partner with a local restaurant.

STEP 2 CONTINUED: BEGIN FUNDRAISING

• Set up a challenge for local businesses.

 Set a fundraising goal and ask the donor to match that amount once you reach it. Don't forget to spread the word on social media to friends and family to help you meet your challenge.

• Raise money using Facebook.

 Once you've registered and are logged into your participant center, you can connect your fundraiser to Facebook so that you can raise money by reaching out to your friends and family on social media. • Ensure your goal is announced so your followers know what you are working towards. Give a special shout out to your donors to encourage others to join your campaign.
